In the 2015/2016 fiscal year, the Foundation granted UCP Seguin funding for the acquisition of a building to further expand the Community Connections Program, a program that has already grown 22 percent since UCP and Seguin merged in 2013. The Foundation also invested in hiring a national expert to provide intensive training and coaching on best practices for community integration and employment services. And since the merger, our funding has contributed to more people served in Community Integrated Living Arrangements (CILAs), Adult Services, Infinitec and Ramp Up programs by an impressive 44 percent.

















